International Baccalaureate (IB)World School

This is a 2 year process that is quite involved. At the end of this process we will still be offering NS Dept. of Ed curriculum, as well as AP courses in addition to the IB curriculum. The decision is to give students more choice of what to study and more choice in how to present themselves and their achievements to universities.

Google School

KVA is now a Google School, and much of our curriculum and normal educational activities can be accomplished with Google Classroom/Drive/Suite, we will be enhancing our distance learning program to first support our in-house students and their ability to work from school or home on any given day, and second to build a strictly distance education program for students who are unable to attend the school daily. For the latter students we will require some time on-campus (science labs, other academic participation and experiences). It is not known exactly what this will look like at the moment.

Next year KVA is enrolling a maximum of 30 students. We are tied in to a lease with NSCAD, and 30 students in this space are at capacity. Tuition has been posted and fees for next year: non-resident tuition (all grades) has gone up a bit. Resident high school will be \$11,300 rather than \$10,500. Junior high for residents will be the same. (Resident refers to citizenship).

Due to some hiccups in tuition and fee payment schedules this year, as well as this current year being the first year of my administration of the school and the changes that came with that, payment of tuition and fees will be negotiated at the time of (re) application on a case-by-case basis, based on financial situation/need as well as payment history with KVA.

Badminton
